Act III

Based on Charles Perrault's fairy tale *La Belle au Bois Dormant*, the plot is centered around the beautiful princess Aurora, who was cursed to 100 years of sleep, by a single prick of her finger on her 16th birthday. Only a Prince's sweet kiss can break the spell and awaken the sleeping beauty.

Act III is the last part of the ballet, when Princess Aurora marries Prince Desiree. It has one scene that starts with the dance of the royal guests followed by the entrance of the fairies and the fairy tale characters from the stories written by Charles Perrault.

GUEST ARTISTS

RICHARD SMITH	 Richard is currently a freelance professional ballet dancer and teacher, originally from Peoria, IL. He has taught and coached several YAGP Top 12 winners in Chicagoland and the Champaign/Urbana area. Richard spent the 2018-2021 seasons as a professional dancer for Peoria's ballet company, performing Principal and Soloist roles such as the Prince in Cinderella, Jonathan Harker in Dracula, Jay Gatsby in Gatsby: The Ballet (an all-Company choreographed show), Raoul in The Phantom of the Opera, as well as Snow King, Flower Cavalier, and the Cavalier/Sugar Plum Adage in The Nutcracker. Richard has appeared as a guest artist throughout the State of Illinois, New York, and Florida. His guest credits include: Snow King, Cavalier, and the Prince in The Nutcracker, Albrecht in Giselle, Espada in Don Quixote, and The Wizard/Flying Monkey in The Wizard of Oz. Richard has trained in Peoria as well as at The Rock School and Urbana Fine Arts Center under such names as Bo & Stephanie Spassoff, Phillip Otto, Rachel Butler, Luciana Rezende, Watmora Casey, Altin Naska, Olena Nalyvaiko, Erich Yetter, Don Coven, Mariaelena Ruiz, and Laura Alonso among others. While Richard currently serves as a faculty member at Virtues in Motion in Yorkville, IL, he is very excited to spend his fifth summer with Ms. Luciana
CORBIN PHILLIPS	Corbin Phillips is a dancer and choreographer based outside of Chicago Illinois. He received a BFA in Dance from the University of Iowa in 2020, with a focus on choreography. Growing up, he trained heavily in ballet and travelled to schools across the country including Ballet Chicago, Next Generation Ballet, Joffrey Ballet and the Dance Theater of Harlem. His choreographic work explores the contrast between his classical training and idiosyncratic movements, while aiming to create a fluidity between the two.

JOE REICHLIN	■ Joe Reichlin studied theater and dance at the University of Kansas before running away from school with the Royal Lichtenstein Circus. He currently teaches circus skills and variety theater with young people, and works full time as a union stagehand. He performs as the Roving Troubadour of the Fairy Tale Ball at the Urbana Free Library, and in addition to previously playing the role of Sancho Panza in the ballet Don Quixote for the UFAC, has recently played The Musician in Borderline and The Sleazy Husband in The Good Woman of Setzuan at the Station Theater.
OLIVIA DRANE	Olivia Drane started her dance training at age 3 at CRS, Savoy, IL, under tutelage of Ms. Christine Rich and Ms. Luciana Rezende. She trained in ballet, jazz, acrobatics, and hip hop. At the age of 11, Olivia began to focus on ballet, under the direction of Ms. Rebekah Von Rathonyi, in Peoria, IL. Olivia was offered a trainee position with Central Illinois Ballet, a professional ballet company based in Peoria, IL. This opportunity facilitated performing alongside professional artists, including a tour to Dallas, TX, where she performed with the Peoria Symphony Orchestra. She also participated in many outreaches within the local community. Olivia has performed at numerous of international ballet competitions where she received training from some of the world's most renowned dance teachers. Olivia currently teaches ballet and coaches students in ballet and contemporary dance at Urbana Fine Arts Center.
KATIE KOPROWSKI	** Katie Koprowski was born in Chicago into an artistic family. Her mother was a dancer/actor, and her father was a writer/producer. By the age of three, she began her formal dance training at the Ruth Page Center for the Arts. Under the tutelage of ballet masters Dolores Long, Birute Barodicaite, Patty Klekovic, and Victor Alexander, Katie learned Cecchetti/RAD/Vaganova ballet, character, and contemporary styles. Throughout high school in the Lincoln Park neighborhood of Chicago, she danced professionally with the Ruth Page Civic Ballet in their Nutcracker, Coppelia, Tarantella, and Midsummer's Night's Dream productions. Today, as a PhD student in Bioengineering at Illinois, Katie teaches/leads weekly advanced ballet classes & artistically directs/produces performances in theater venues across campus for Illinois Ballet Companythe newest professional-level college ballet troupe at the University of Illinois. At Urbana Fine Arts, she teaches floor barre and ballet silver.
